

Dependency Status Documentation



Requirements:Must be completed for anyone under age 25 in the following programs:Youth Program:Dependent status must be documented for all WIOA eligible youth applicants, ages 14-24Adult Program:Dependent status must be documented for all WIOA adults, ages 18-24, who are applying for WIOA adult-funded individual training accounts (ITAs).
Age:
Under 18
An individual under 18 years of age is always considered to be a dependent child, unless the youth is NOT living with parents or guardians and is NOT receiving ANY support from them.
If BOTH are true, provide signed documentation, otherwise youth is dependent.
If 18-24, a participant is independent if answering YES to any question below and providing documentation:
Vecentia
Yes or NoAre you married (including separated, but not divorced)?
Do you live in your own residence or in a residence without financial or other support from parents or guardians?
Are you on active duty in the U.S. armed forces for purposes other than training?
Are you a veteran of the U.S. armed forces?
Use worksheet to document support for below questions:
Do you provide more than half of your own support?
Do you have children that receive more than half of their support from you?
Do you have other dependents that receive more than half of their support from you?

If any question is answered YES, then individual is independent if supporting documentation is provided.
